

BYLAW NO. 97

SUMMER VILLAGE OF SOUTH VIEW, ALBERTA

A ByLaw of the Summer Village of South View in the Province of Alberta to provide for the imposition of penalties on unpaid taxes.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of South View, in the province of Alberta, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1 assented to June 1, 1994 deems it expedient to impose penalties on unpaid taxes;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Summer Village of South View, in the Province of Alberta enacts as follows:

1. Taxes shall be paid on or before June 30th in the year in which they are levied.
2. Taxes not paid by June 30th in any year in which they are levied shall have a penalty of 18% imposed on them on July 1st in that year.
3. Taxes not paid by December 31st in the year in which they are levied shall have an additional penalty of 18% imposed on them on January 1st of the succeeding year and each year thereafter so long as the taxes remain unpaid.
4. Upon passing of this ByLaw, ByLaw No. 79 is repealed.
