Election Year

Garbage Pickup

Garbage pickup over the winter months is bi-weekly. Please take the time to break down boxes etc. to reduce bulky items in the bins. All non-allowable items such as microwaves, stereos, TVs, kitchen chairs, furniture, shingles and other building debris are to be taken by you to the Regional Landfill Site located on Highway 43 where you will be required to pay tippage fees accordingly. Please be advised that any abuse or illegal dumping of materials may result in charges back to the offender.

Encroachments on Municipal Road Right of Ways / Items Stored on Municipal Reserves

It is the responsibility of every property owner to understand and know where their property lines are. If you are unsure of your property boundaries, it is your responsibility to have your lot surveyed. If there happens to be items encroaching on Summer Village property they will need to be moved to within your property.

To facilitate park maintenance in the summer months and to ensure safety of all users during the winter months, boat hoists and piers etc. are required to be removed from all park reserve areas to private property. Failure to do so may result in the Summer Village having the items removed at the owner's expense.

Windrow Removal

We thank those that use their quads to clear snow off the roads or driveways within the Summer Village. If by chance windrows are caused across driveways, please take time to remove them.

Speeding & ATV Use in the Summer Village

Adherence to the Summer Village speed limits are imperative for the safety of everyone. The speed limit throughout the Summer Village is 30km/hour and lanes/alleys are 15km/hour. The speed limit of 30km/hour is for ALL motor vehicles, including ATV's and Snow Machines.

Just a reminder to all residents that operating ATV's and Snow Machines within the Summer Village is a privilege, not a right, and the use within the Summer Village can be taken away at any time for all, even if it is just a few users not abiding to the rules. Please review bylaw 165 – Off Highway Vehicles; to update yourself on the rules and regulations.
